Finally within the code just pasted remove the first line that reads:

Your page is now complete, simply upload to your web page to your own server and start blogging with your mobile.

## Editing A Pre-made Example

Everything that you need in order to make changes to an example is available within the page you have just created. The majority of the styling, in standard CSS, can be found between the head tags of the HTML file. Some images and basic styling can be found in the body.

Before the CSS, at the start of the head tag, we have included a small piece of script to ensure PNG images are displayed correctly in Internet Explorer 6.

Styles that affect the appearance of the SMSBlog itself can be found in the CSS under the title "/\* Blog \*/" whilst styles that affect the surrounding page can be found just above this at the beginning of the CSS.

The body contains the SMSBlog code, modified as described above, along with extra code above and beneath it to control headers and footers.

All these elements can be edited and altered to achieve any desired look, either resembling one of the 4 examples shown or one of your very own. Have fun and remember your imagination's the limit!

Please note: The imported Webmaster code should not be altered except to remove/include any links to external styling sheets.
